3. Installing the flue system. 1. Locate the wood fire in its proposed position and mark a point on the ceiling that is directly above the centre of the wood fire's flue spigot. Check that the wood fire's location allows the outer casing to clear all structural roof timbers. 2. Cut a 250mm square hole in ceiling.

### Standard Flue System Installation Manual

When installing a new twinwall flue system, if the flue exits the roof within 600mm (horizontally) from the ridge (high point) of the roof then the flue must extend a minimum of 600mm above the ridge. If the flue exits the roof further down then it must extend high enough to acheive 2.3m of horizontal clearance.

Flue height regulations Flues need to be 600mm higher than the highest part of the roof within 3 metres. Flues that are more than 3 metres away from the highest part of the roof need to be 1000mm above the flue penetration.

Simply measure the distance from the top of the "as installed" appliance flue collar to the "as built" height of the chimney chase. After that, add any height needed above the chimney chase for a storm collar and chimney cap. This measurement is usually between 8-12 inches, though it can vary by brand.

### Installation Guidelines - HETAS

Basic Regulations to Follow. If you are using a high efficiency boiler model, make sure that the flues should have more plumbing to them than in case with older boilers. Never place the flue outlet under the windows, opposite property walls, near doors and close to the neighbor's boundaries.

### Gas Boiler Flue Regulations: Things to Know before ...

(1) The clearance between masonry or concrete chimneys and combustible framing material shall be not less than, (a) 50... (2) A clearance of not less than 150 mm shall be provided between a cleanout opening and combustible material.

☐ The wood fire must be operated in accordance with the manufactures instructions, local clean air guidelines and regulations. ☐ The flue must be installed in accordance with GDA installation instructions, using flue components supplied by GDA. It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure no water leaks into the flue system

### Installation Instructions

In the case that your current flue doesn't meet any of these regulations, faces out onto a public path below a height of 2.1 metres for example, then you may need to install a new boiler. However, many of the regulations only apply to new boiler installations so it's worth checking with a qualified heating engineer.
